UPDATE: Pedestrian Safety Ordinance

In November more than 30 community members spoke out at City Council against the proposed “Pedestrian Safety” ordinance, which regulates pedestrian behavior on medians instead of fixing dangerous streets. The ordinance was tabled until various commissions and committees could provide feedback. The bill will return for a vote on Monday, **February 2, 2026**.

During its November 19, 2025 meeting The Bicycle and Pedestrian Commission voted 7-0 to recommend that City Council **not pass** Bill No. B265-25, as written.

1. The proposed ordinance places most of the responsibility for safety on vulnerable road users.
2. The ordinance does not address mitigating vehicle speed, traffic volume and roadway conditions, which are major factors in pedestrian crashes.
3. The ordinance would inhibit pedestrians’ access to major parts of Columbia.

Pedestrian Safety Ordinance – Be Heard!

The City of Columbia is seeking community input on a proposed Pedestrian Safety Ordinance related to activity in certain roadway environments. The ordinance was developed following a Street and Intersection Pedestrian Safety Study, which examined local crash data, roadway conditions and national safety practices. The study identified locations where higher speeds, greater traffic volumes and narrow medians may increase the risk of conflicts between pedestrians and vehicles.

The proposed ordinance would establish rules for pedestrians and motorists at intersections and roadways meeting specific criteria. These include locations where at least one of the following applies, to at least one adjacent roadway:

- A speed limit of 35 mph or higher
- Traffic volumes greater than 15,000 vehicles per day
- Medians less than six feet wide
